UTAR Library will organize **Online Information Skills Programme** to all students via **Microsoft Teams** from **14 February until 25 February 2022**.

This programme is to guide students to search for information and to optimize the use of library resources for their assignments and projects. Students will also learn on how to evaluate the internet resources effectively and how to avoid plagiarism in their writing.


There are 6 modules for this programme which will be covered in 2 parts, as follows:

Part 1: Searching Strategies and Techniques (a 2-hour class to cover Module 1 to Module 3)

- Module 2: Effective Database Searching
- Module 3: Evaluation of Web Resources

Part 2: Plagiarism and Referencing (a 2-hour class to cover Module 4 to Module 6)

- Module 4: Plagiarism
- Module 5: Referencing
- Module 6: Reference Management Tool
